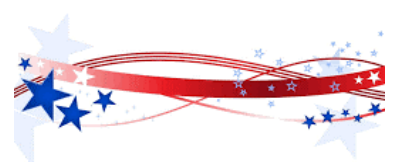
East will continue to use the sign-in sheet protocol for Sunday mornings.

~ Watonwan County Food Shelf Free Produce Distribution

The distributions in July are scheduled for Thursday, July 14th and July 28th. As always, ANYONE is able to attend the free produce distributions, there are no income restrictions.

How Distributions Will Work:

- * The distribution is at the Food Shelf, not at Memorial Park.
- * Customers can enter through the front door.
- * Hours to pick up produce will be from 12 p.m. (noon)- 6 p.m. or until we run out of produce.
- * The rest of the food shelf will not be open to use, these hours will be only to pick up produce.
- * Produce will not be pre-bagged, customers will bag their own produce and take what they can use.
- * We will have 1 hour volunteer shifts during this time frame where we would like to see 4-5 volunteers at a time.
- * As a volunteer, you will show people where to register (they only write down their family size), remove rotten produce from the pallets of produce as needed, and help carry out produce for customers as needed.

The AES Joint Council met on Thursday, June 2, 2022, at East Sveadahl. Those present were Tom Anderson, Teresa Andrews, Sandy Berg, Janet Bloomquist, Deanna Hoffman, Mark Kulseth, Mike Menssen, Pr. Mandy, and Susan Anderson. Becky Cobb was absent.

In the absence of Becky Cobb, Tom Anderson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with a quorum present. He opened the meeting by asking for prayer concerns.

Pr. Mandy led us in prayer

A motion was made by Deanna, seconded by Mark, and carried to approve the May minutes.

Pastor Mandy's report:

- She conducted the funeral for Viola Sandberg
- She officiated at a wedding June 4th at Augustana.
- Senior Recognition Sunday will be June 5th at Augustana for three seniors and June 12th at East for one senior.
- Vacation Bible School is June 7,8,9 from 8:30 – 11:30 am at Augustana. There is a need for sound and tech people to help those mornings.
- She started a Walking Club. They walk on Tuesday mornings and/or Wednesday nights.
- The Ministerium is looking at other ways for fellowship opportunities to take place in our community. Some possibilities might be an ecumenical kickball or softball league.
- There has been one applicant to interview for the Youth Director Position.
- The Synod Assembly was cancelled due to the fact that not enough delegates registered to meet the quorum requirement. Any business will now be handled by the Synod Council.
- The Baccalaureate Service was also cancelled due to lack of parental interest.
- The logistics of the July Camp Out are being handled by the Youth Committee.

OLD BUSINESS

Mark stated that the April Augustana Council minutes were addressed and clarified.

The Safe Haven issue is being addressed. Becky Cobb had a letter attached to the agenda explaining her findings in regard to Safe Haven. She has presented this information to the Committee (Judy Berg, Jill Beckius, Lori Urevig, Lisa Shellum, and Becky).

NEW BUSINESS

Pr. Mandy reported that the First Presbyterian Church is also looking to hire a Youth Director. After discussion, a motion was made (Janet), seconded (Mike), and carried to begin conversation about the possibility of sharing a Youth Director.

-Mark called the meeting to order at 7:05PM. Devotions were given by Sandy.

-Lynn made a motion, seconded by Kyla to approve the minutes from the May meeting as printed. Motion carried.

-Judy presented the Treasurer's Report. Recipients for the proceeds from Noisy Offerings have not always been determined in advance so a schedule for the year was recommended. Evangelism/Social Ministry Committee will follow up on this to create a schedule so that members know where the offering is going, and Judy can disburse the money in a timely manner. Judy discussed her findings regarding Direct Deposit for staff pay checks. Further inquiry will be made so no action was taken at this time.

-Deanna presented the giving report.

Pastor Mandy—

-The people that are currently working with the technology are doing a great job, but more help is definitely needed. There is a lot of work that goes on "behind the scenes" in preparation for services, etc. The council puts out a plea to members to step up and assist with the technology, so the work does not fall on the same few people. Training will be provided for anyone that is interested in helping. Also, more song leaders for worship services are needed. Lisa and Allison will work with anyone that is interested in helping with this. A schedule for the summer has been started.

-Wedding of Justine Beckius and Kyle Rozeboom took place at Augustana on June 4th with Mandy officiating.

-Vacation Bible School started on Tuesday with 41 kids in attendance, 17 attending from First Presbyterian. There are 3 days planned, with the last day on Thursday. Much decorating and set up has been done that relates to the Railroad theme being used.

-Mandy will be conducting a Memorial service and Burial for Lanny Overson on Saturday, June 11th. Lanny died in February.

-Pastor Mandy has been able to make more face-to-face visits with restrictions lessening some.

-Will be on vacation June 22-27th.

-Synod Assembly was cancelled due to lack of a quorum.

AES Ministries—

-Safe Haven committee has been established and are working on policy/guidelines.

-Ministerium is working to formulate a Kickball or Softball team.

-Pastor Mandy has started a Walking Group. The walk is Tuesdays at 6:30AM or Wednesdays at 6:00PM. The group begins and ends at church.

-Ongoing work to hire a Youth Director. An interview is scheduled for Monday, June 13th, but alternate plans need to be made for TLC as prep begins in July/August.

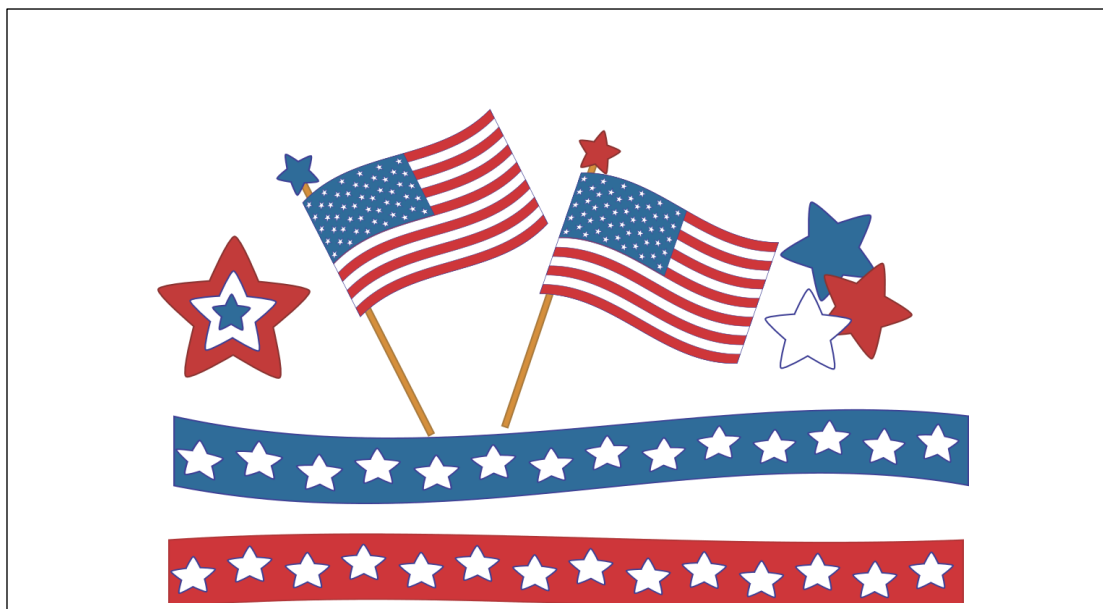
