AES JOINT COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES – October 7, 2019

The AES Ministries Joint Council met on Thursday, October 7, 2021, at 7:00 pm at Augustana following protocols – masking and social distancing. Those present: Janet Bloomquist, Becky Cobb, Terry Engel, Wayne Jurgens, Susan Anderson, and Pr. Mandy. Not present: Teresa Andrews, Leora Ask, Mike Menssen, Mark Kulseth. Visitor: Erica Garza

Wayne called the meeting to order. Pr. Mandy opened the meeting with prayer.

A motion was made (Janet), seconded (Terry), and carried to approve the minutes as presented in the newsletter.

PR. MANDY’S REPORT

Pr. Mandy has been busy with visitations, confirmation, adjusting to her many roles, and is concerned, with everything that is happening, that nothing gets overlooked. She would strongly encourage AES Ministries to find a Youth Coordinator to take care of their activities.

In order to find a way to help with their work loads, the Board asked that Pr. Mandy and Erica outline on paper the jobs that they do and can handle, and then, the jobs that need to be done and aren’t getting done. The Board can then look at how to provide help.

Erica is working more hours than she was contracted for. A motion was made (Janet), seconded (Terry) to compensate Erica for the hours she works which she will submit on a monthly timecard. The motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

(cont.)

Pr. Mandy and Erica presented information for discussion about TLC. Some of the discussion topics were: busing options, how to best spend the additional time the children are here (2-5:30 pm instead of 3:15-5:30), how to deal with COVID protocols to best protect our children, the idea of adding service projects for the children and how to staff them, how to prevent staff burnout, and the absolute need for more help, and the how and the where to get that help.

COVID protocols were reviewed and discussed. Everyone agrees that the guidelines and protocols present concerns and mandates that aren't agreeable to everyone. It must be understood by all that the plan is set up to keep all of our members safe and keep the church open. If the churches are to stay open, certain protocols must be in place and followed!

The answer to whether the church is open or if masks are needed is made after the numbers are released each Friday and can be found on the church website, on Facebook, and in an email that comes directly to you if we have your email address. If you are concerned, check these sources. We must all do our best to accept graciously the protocol that the Joint Council outlines.

Pr. Mandy will send our protocol to the Watonwan County Public Health office for reviewal. After their reviewal, the Council will reevaluate the proposal.

A motion was made (Terry), and seconded (Becky) to approve the Pastor's salary and insurance package for 2022 which will be the same as currently set. The motion passed.

The next meeting will be Thursday, November 4th, 7:00 pm at Augustana.

Mark called the meeting to order at 7:30PM in the Social Hall and Dean shared devotions to open the meeting.

Reports:

Motion by John, seconded by Lynn to approve the Secretary's Report as printed. Motion carried.

Motion by Lynn, seconded by Lisa to approve the Treasurers Report as printed. Motion carried.

Judy reported on Congregational Consulting Company-an Employer Retention Project related to retaining employees during the COVID pandemic. Judy took all the paperwork out to Suzann Olson to review and Suzann said everything looked good. Judy has submitted the paperwork. At some point, the amount received for Augustana will be \$18,165.57. The fee to be paid to the rep is \$1,500. Thank you, Judy Thulien, for completing all the paperwork. Much appreciated.

The Secretary and Custodial positions have been posted on Indeed.com. There will be a charge for each applicant that applies for the position.

There continues to be some confusion with the church credit card. Mandy has received the card in her name and will be calling to straighten it out as she now has a card in her name.

Deanna presented the Giving Report. Offering envelopes have arrived and will be mailed out to members.

Pastor Mandy

Currently ministering to many that have health concerns/crises, including some health concerns for her own son, Elijah. The Food Shelf is putting together food baskets for Thanksgiving and Pastor Mandy will be having the confirmations students help with the baskets.

AES Ministries

Erica's position-currently gets paid for 5 hours a week. Erica is an AES employee and she will be paid for the hours that she turns in. This will be handled by the AES Board.

Cindy Torkelson and Deb Anderson came to the meeting to share concerns about the TLC status. Early Out at school is even earlier so the students are arriving by 1:45PM and are present for TLC for a long period of time (1:45-6PM). Originally TLC was for Kindergarten-6th grade. It is now Kindergarten-8th grade so there are more students. 40-45 students are currently attending. Plan to add Community Service Projects. There is a need for Youth Director. Erica spoke to Wed eve church service and will speak to both church services on Sunday to make the needs known. More adult helpers are needed to be able to continue this program.

Cindy and Deb also suggested the idea of a Booster Club to support students going to Green Lake Bible Camp, the Jr. High Youth Gathering in Willmar-November 20th, the Sr. High Gathering-July 20-24, 2022 in Minneapolis, and Vacation Bible School. Discussion regarding this was tabled. (cont.)

Education-covered by Cindy and Deb.

Evangelism/Social Ministry/Education-Confusion about wearing a mask, not wearing a mask and how congregation members can be informed-on Facebook, church website, possibly answering machine message, sign on the door, etc. Lisa gets number from Julia at Public Health and that is the number that is used. The protocol that had been developed earlier this fall is being reviewed and revised as needed. Input from Watonwan Public Health Director has been solicited and currently waiting to have a few questions answered. Pastor Mandy has been receiving quite a few calls from members with ongoing questions. After much discussion, the protocol will continue to be reviewed and revised. As of this meeting, it will be MANDATORY for all in attendance at TLC (adults and students) to wear masks. Anyone refusing to wear a mask, will be asked to leave. If a student is kept home from school because they are ill, they SHOULD NOT attend TLC.

Finance-need to start working on the budget for 2022.

Property-Rognlie trimmed the bushes around church. Sound booth is in the process of being built. Payment has been made on the stained-glass window project. John will be notified when the company is ready to start.

AES EDUCATION COMMITTEE REPORT - October 12, 2021

We began with a prayer and thoughts that we need to ask ourselves; "What gifts have been given us? and may God guide us in God's World."

Treasurer's Report:

Old Business:

We discussed our curriculum, Dig In. It is going well for all levels.

The 3rd graders will get their Bibles October 24th, and the Mentor Program for the Confirmation students will begin in November. The 7th and 8th graders will be working with the TLC students as part of their confirmation. This is Catechism year for the 9th and 10th graders learning what it means to be a Lutheran.

The Faith Family Formation magazines from Spark will continue to be mailed out four times a year to our TLC families.

Becky's Adult Prayer Session continues on Mondays at 10 am. They are going well.

New Business:

- We discussed mask usage for TLC, and we will go along with our AES Covid Team which follows the Watonwan Public Health Covid team.
- We have concerns for our students that are not getting picked up at 5:20 pm. We are looking into a policy for the situation.
- Erica has asked families to have the Heja (hi ya) app for better communication. This is an app that is used with our Sports Booster Clubs in town. It has been working very well with schedule, mask, and transportation changes.
- School has early outs every Wednesday which has led to adding more to our TLC afternoon. So, the students will be adding service projects into the schedule. They have written to vets and next will be working on Operation Christmas Shoebox which is through the Samaritan Purse. There will be tubs at each church so parishioners can help our project. At the end of October, they will have a Fun Fall Festival planned with all the students.
