When in a play, like "A Christmas Carol," we see greed and conflict and its effects, we are moved to examine our own lives. Or, we are moved to greater understanding and compassion for others. There is something about a live performance that connects us in ways reading a book or seeing a movie can't. Live theater also sparks our imagination and our creativity, and we begin to dream of what is possible in our own lives and for the world. This particular play, a classic, has inspired generations to a more meaningful Christmas. A Christmas of remembering and celebrating why it is God sent Jesus for us.

LEFSE RECIPE

3 C. Mashed Russet Potatoes 1 Tbsp. sugar

½ stick butter (1/4 c.) 1 c. flour (add right before rolling)

2 Tbsp. cream or half & half 1 tsp. salt

Cook Russet potatoes until just done; don't overcook as they tend to absorb water.

Drain and mash or rice them well. Measure out 3 cups and add the butter and cream.

Mix in the sugar and salt. The flour will be added just before we roll the lefse.

The East Sveadahl Church Council met on Thursday, October 11, 2018 at 7 p.m. Those present were Tom Anderson, Janet Bloomquist, Evonne Moll, Erma Griffith, Lori Urevig, George Nasman, Wayne Jurgens, Pastor Kathleen, and Susan Anderson.

The meeting opened with prayer by Pastor Kathleen.

Secretary, Janet Bloomquist, read the minutes from the September 13th East Council meeting. Minutes were approved as read.

FAITHFUL – Generosity is based upon the obedience to, the conviction of, the dependence upon, and the assurance of God's promises.


REGULAR – Like breath itself, our generosity is essential to a full and healthy Christian life.
