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### *From the Pastor*

**September!** Normally we'd be thinking of school buses, changing schedules, and fall colors. We'd be coming off four months of relaxing activities and be re-energized for the upcoming routines. There would be a focus on activities unique each fall. We would be anticipating what comes next. The key word here is "normally".

This year is anything BUT normal. We've been asked to stay at home for the sake of our neighbor. We've been warned repeatedly to be careful, wash our hands, and stay away from crowds. And we've been told to wear masks whenever we go into public buildings. These are confusing and frustrating times for many of us. Almost daily there are changes in recommendations about our safety; from health practices to physical distancing. Aargh! I recently mentioned to a group how I've been doing a lot of groaning these past 5 months. These are NOT our preferred realities.

You need to know. The church councils have been attentive to the many Covid19 details. There have been a great number of protocols to consider as they put safety first. The securest route for worship continues to be virtual via Facebook, radio, or TV. We've also been doing Drive-Up worship during August and that has gone well. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation! There is no question that we all want to open the church buildings and return to familiar activities. But, opening too quickly or in an undisciplined manner is risky. As we move forward, some of the guidelines for face-to-face worship include: limited numbers of people in the building, physical distancing, no singing, rigorous cleaning and disinfecting all touched surfaces, no hymnals in the sanctuary, and face masks for everyone. Our plan is to re-open for "in the building" worship on September 6<sup>th</sup>. We will move to our Fall schedule of worship times: 9:00 at Augustana and 10:45 at East Sveadahl. There will be a number of protocols in place. Only one entrance will be usable, worshippers will need to sign in, access to other parts of the building will be limited, masks will be required, half of the pews will be taped off, no coffee... We will keep you informed and posted about details. The JOY will be in re-opening.

#### **Interim Process:**

It's typical for people to get impatient at this point in the Interim period. They begin to think things are not moving quickly enough. Their impatience stems from 1.) not understanding what is happening ... and 2.) wanting to just simply get back to normal. That seems particularly true this year with the anxiety from Covid19 affecting us all. It's a complicated year!

Let me outline the sequence we are in. We have already launched the Transition Team.

The **Transition Team** is a working group that compiles, documents, and edits the vital information about a congregation. We are using a Mission Assessment Process as our pathway for imagining God's future for AES Ministries. The purpose is to discover what talents, needs, and possibilities are important for our churches. The Transition Team does the prep work. It coordinates with congregational leadership and will generate two reports – a **Mission Assessment Report (MAP)** and a **Ministry Site Profile (MSP)**. These reports will be reviewed by both church councils and will be presented to the congregation. When the Call Committee starts, these reports will help them step into the future, quickly move to recruiting, and make solid recommendation(s) to the congregations.

The **Call Committee** recruits, interviews, and recommends a new pastor. It is formed after the Transition Team has completed its work. They will receive training about the interview process and be briefed on the documents prepared by the Transition Team. The Call Committee will be representative of the congregation and include some members from the Transition Team. After the Call Committee has done its work of recruiting and interviewing, they will discern the candidate with a profile that meshes best with AES Ministries Mission Assessment. That individual will then be recommended to the congregations for approval.

Your **Transition Team** has begun the process of Mission Assessment. This takes time, prayerful thought, and intentional information gathering. It is important progression that identifies the realities of the congregation(s) and God's possibilities for our future. Please include them in your prayers.

We came out ahead at the end of July – but just barely. All of the money from the PPP loan has been used and as I reported last month, we are not eligible for any additional loan money. In speaking with the bank, they recommended not being too anxious to proceed with the paperwork for the loan forgiveness. The SBA has not given instruction to them at this time how to proceed so their best advice was to wait.

The council has been researching the purchase of an updated camera that could both stream our live worship service and record a service/event to be broadcast at a later time. The costs to consider in this purchase include the camera, software maybe a laptop computer and someone to teach us how to use it. This is not a budgeted expense but our world now requires us to think outside the box and look at other ways we can reach a broader membership.
